

Hot Spots / Wi-Fi off-campus

ETH students and staff can use infrastructure provided by other universities, organisations and Wireless Internet Service Providers ([WISP](#)) to build a direct VPN connection to ETH without local authentication.

Network Access off-campus

This service is free of charge for ETH employees and students. Cooperating WISPs provide the technical structure for a direct VPN connection to ETH Zurich while ITS ICT-Networks operates the necessary VPN infrastructure and enables connectivity from ETH to WISP VPN servers.

SWITCHconnect Classic surfing at Swiss universities (formerly SWITCHmobile)

ETH Zurich, like most universities and technical colleges, is a member of [SWITCHconnect](#). The [SWITCH](#) foundation has been operating the Swiss academic and research network since 1987. This allows ETH students and staff free use of WLAN at participating university campuses. Access is granted automatically and users don't need local authentication.

MOBILE-EAPSIM

SWITCHconnect EDUROAM surfing at universities worldwide

("Education Roaming") allows students and staff visiting participating universities and organizations to log on to Wireless LAN using the same credentials (username and password) the user would use if he were at his home institution. By now, virtually all European countries are incorporated in eduroam and a growing number of their universities are joining its research network. Outside of Europe as well it gathered consensus quite soon with initial support coming from the Asian Pacific region. Each organization makes its wireless infrastructure generally available; authentication is done at the user's home organisation by mean of RADIUS interconnection.

User ID

The differentiation of user IDs is done by entering a realm. Instead of entering just the usual user_name, outside of the home organisation user_name@my_organisation should be entered. e.g.:

- *login: (nethz-login)@ethz.ch*
- *Password: (network password)*

The request is then automatically forwarded to the right server. In Switzerland eduroam activities are coordinated by SWITCH. An overview can be found on the [EDUROAM](#) site.
